ANNUAL BACKFLOW PREVENTION ASSEMBLY TESTING

DID YOU KNOW? common hazards in and around your house can contaminate your drinking water as well as your neighbors?

These hazards are known as **cross-connections** and can result in contaminated water backflowing into your homes drinking water supply without you even knowing.

Your in-ground irrigation system is a cross-connection and requires your attention. In-ground landscape irrigation systems are the most common cross-connections found.



If your property has an in-ground irrigation system, it is your responsibility to make sure these steps are followed <u>annually</u>:



- 1
- Confirm that your irrigation system has an approved backflow prevention assembly.
- Have the assembly tested by a certified tester and submit the report to the City of Coburg for property compliance recording.
